# † From the Pastor †

A 98-year-old Methodist minister shared this story. "On my second church appointment, I had never been in the church before. It was locked. I went to a banker who had the key. He smiled when I said I would like the key to the church so I could see what it looked like. He said, 'I'll go with you.' He took me to a place in the church – the pew where he said Uncle Billy Edwards sat. He was a charter member. The carpet was literally worn out where he sat. You may think it strange someone did not patch the carpet. I have thanked God that someone never did. It was good to see a place in the church where one man sat so many times that he wore out the carpet.

"Uncle Billy Edwards had a stroke and died soon after I arrived in that community. The day after his passing I happened to be in a grocery store and the manager said, 'I hear that Uncle Billy Edwards died last night.' I said 'yes.' Then he told me: 'I can tell you now something I never was permitted to tell while he was alive. He would come to the store, buy \$10 to \$15 worth of groceries and tell us to take it to some poor person and not ever to tell them who sent it.'"

Of course, my experience is with Catholic congregations, but I suspect that the same phenomenon occurs in all denominations – many people tend to sit in the same location week after week. And some have been coming

for so long, they could have worn out the carpet and the kneeler and the seat of the pew.

The beautiful lesson of the story of Uncle Billy is that as he was faithful in coming to listen to the message of Jesus in church, he was also faithful in putting it into practice when he left the church. It is the challenge each of us faces every weekend.

As we hear the words of St. Paul in today's second reading reminding us that we are called to be holy, we pause to remember the little sins we are comfortable in accepting as part of our life with God. Jesus calls us to love one another as he has loved us, but we remember the irritation we felt because someone was in our pew when we got there today! The condition for following Jesus is accepting the cross as a part of our life, but we would prefer to have all things be comfortable and easy and not too demanding in our religious life or in our relationships with others.

We can wear out our place in church and leave feeling satisfied with our holiness and faithfulness to God. But, as Uncle Billy reminds us, what we receive here in church is meant to be put into practice in our daily life outside the church building. Jesus speaks to us today – and the proof that we have heard his voice will be discovered in how we put his message into practice the rest of the week.

Un ministro Metodista de 98 años compartió su historia. “En mi segundo nombramiento de iglesia, yo nunca avía entrado a la iglesia. Estaba con llave. Fui a un banquero que tenia la llave. El

sonrió cuando le dije que me gustaría la llave a la iglesia para ver como era. Me dijo, “Voy con usted”. My llevo a un lugar dentro la iglesia—al banco en donde dio que se sienta el Tío Billy Edwards. El era un fundador. La alfombra en donde se sentaba el estaba literalmente consumida por el uso. Lo pensarías extraño que alguien no arreglaba la carpeta. Yo le he dado gracias a Dios que alguien nunca lo arreglo. Era bueno ver un lugar dentro de la iglesia en donde un hombre se sentó tantas veces que arruino la carpeta.

“Tío Billy Edwards tuvo un derrame murió un poco después de que llegue a esa comunidad. El día después de su muerte yo estuve en una tienda y el encargado me dijo, “Escuche que Tío Billy Edwards murió anoche.” Yo le conteste, “Si”. Después me dijo, “Ya le puedo contar algo que nunca pude decir cuando el estaba vivo. El llegaba a la tienda, compraba \$10 a \$15 de comida y nos decía que se lo lleváramos a una persona pobre y que nunca contemos quien lo mandaba.”

Claro, mi experiencia es con congregaciones Católicas, pero sospecho que el mismo fenómeno ocurre in todas dominaciones—muchas personas tienden sentarse en el mismo asiento semana tras semana. Y varios han estado viniendo tanto tiempo que podrían haber gastado la alfombra, el reclinatorio, y el asiento del banco.

La lección bella de la historia de Tío Billy es que igual a su fidelidad a escuchar el mensaje de Jesús también era fiel en ponerlo en practica cuando se iba. Es un reto que cada uno de nosotros se enfrenta todos los fines de semana.

Al escuchar las palabras de San Pablo en la segunda lectura, recordándonos que somos llamados a ser santos, hacemos una pausa para recordar los pecados pequeños que estamos cómodos en aceptar como parte de nuestra vida con Dios. Jesús nos llama a amarnos unos a otros como el nos ha amado pero nos acordamos la irritación que sentimos porque alguien estaba en nuestra

banca cuando llegamos hoy. La condición para seguir a Jesús es aceptando la cruz como parte de nuestra vida, pero preferimos que todo sea confortable y fácil y no muy exigentes en nuestra vida religiosa ni en nuestras amistad con otros.

Podemos gastar nuestro lugar en la iglesia y salir sintiéndonos satisfechos con nuestra santidad y fidelidad con Dios. Pero, como Tio Billy nos recuerda, lo que recibimos aquí en la iglesia es para ponerlo en practica en nuestra vida diaria fuera de la iglesia. Jesus nos habla hoy—y la prueba que hemos escuchado su voz estará descubierto en como ponemos su mensaje a practica el resto de la semana.
