† From the Pastor †

Today's readings focus on one of our most beloved images of Jesus – the Good Shepherd. Even though our personal experience of shepherds and sheep is mostly theoretical, we are comforted by the idea that we are being protected and watched over by someone who loves us completely.

At a large university some years ago a rather famous poet came to read his poetry. After the reading, a woman asked if he would read the twenty-third Psalm. He agreed, and with flawless execution he rendered the Psalm. The crowd was impressed. They clapped their hands in praise.

Yet another request came from the crowd. Someone asked that a local retired Pastor who was in the audience read the Psalm also. And with a voice cracking with age and colored with country twang the old Pastor falteringly read Psalm twenty-three. And this time the people wept.

Stepping to the microphone the poet commented on the crowd's response. "I see what the difference is," he said. "I know the Psalm, but he knows the Shepherd!"

Our challenge is to make sure that our acquaintance with the Shepherd is not simply a pious notion or a literary theme in our life. We profess that we follow Jesus so closely that we carry his name – we call our self a Christian. But we have to consider if Christ actually is leading us through our day.

Faced with uncertainties as we

consider the future and only see troubles and darkness ahead, there is a voice leading us to follow him and trust that he will be with us just as surely in the future as he has been in the past – the Good Shepherd will not leave us to wander alone.

Faced with pain and troubles that weigh us down until we feel we simply can't imagine going on, there is one who loves us and carries us and our burdens on his shoulder – the Good Shepherd will lend us his strength.

Faced with people who disappoint us, and those who do not appreciate our goodness, and someone whose need for our help seems to be without limit, there is one who sees the good in every person, and knows that every

cross will lead to sharing in his glory, one who gave all that he had to show us how much we are loved. The Good Shepherd is always searching for us, making sure that we see the world around us with his eyes.

We may go for years without ever seeing a real-life shepherd leading his sheep. They just don't appear in Dallas, Texas very often. But, think about what that image means – we are surrounded by love, protected by strength, led with assurance through a difficult world. Our call is to be sure we are listening for his voice. The Good Shepherd is calling. Do we know him well enough to hear his voice?

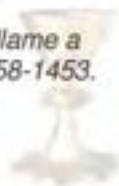

Las lecturas de hoy se centran en una de nuestras imágenes más queridas de Jesús - el Buen Pastor. A pesar de que nuestra experiencia personal de los pastores y las ovejas es sobre todo teórico, nos consuela la idea de que estamos siendo protegidos y vigilados por alguien que nos ama completamente.

En una gran universidad hace unos años un poeta famoso llegó a leer su poesía. Después de la lectura, una mujer le preguntó si podía leer el Salmo 23. Estuvo de acuerdo, y con una ejecución perfecta, presento el Salmo. El público quedó impresionado, aplaudiendo las manos en alabanza.

Sin embargo, otra solicitud provino de la multitud. Alguien pidió que un pastor retirado local que estaba en la audiencia leyera el Salmo también. Y con una voz quebrada por la edad y de colorida con acento el pastor viejo vacilantemente leyó el Salmo 23. Y esta vez la gente lloró.

Pasando hacia el micrófono el poeta comento a la respuesta de la multitud, "Yo veo cuál es la diferencia", el dijo, "Yo me se el Salmo, pero el conoce al Pastor!"

Nuestro desafío es asegurarnos de que nuestra relación con el Pastor no es simplemente una idea piadosa o un tema literario en nuestra vida. Profesamos que seguimos a Jesús tan de cerca que llevamos su nombre - que nos llamamos un cristiano. Pero tenemos que considerar si Cristo realmente nos está llevando a través de nuestro día.

Frente a la incertidumbre en

cuanto consideramos el futuro y sólo vemos problemas y la oscuridad por delante, hay una voz que nos lleva a seguirlo y confiar que él estará con nosotros con tanta seguridad en el futuro como lo ha sido en el pasado - el Buen Pastor no nos va a dejar de vagar solo.

Ante el dolor y los problemas que nos agobian hasta que sentimos que simplemente no podemos imaginar seguir adelante, hay alguien que nos ama y nos lleva a nosotros y nuestras cargas en el hombro - el Buen Pastor nos prestan su fuerza.

Frente a las personas que nos defraudan, y aquellos que no aprecian nuestra bondad, y alguien cuya necesidad de nuestra ayuda parece no tener limite, hay uno que ve lo bueno en cada persona, y sabe que cada cruz llevará a compartir su gloria, que dio todo lo que tenía para mostrarnos cuánto nos ama. El Buen Pastor está siempre en busca de nosotros, asegurándose de que miremos el mundo a nuestro alrededor con sus ojos.

Podemos pasar años sin ver a un pastor en la vida real guiando sus ovejas. Ellos simplemente no aparecen en Dallas, Texas, muy a menudo. Pero, piense en lo que la imagen de los medios - que estamos rodeados por el amor, protegidos por la fuerza, guiados con seguridad a través de un mundo difícil. Nuestro llamado es estar seguros de que estamos escuchando su voz. El Buen Pastor está llamando. ¿Lo conocemos lo suficiente como para escuchar su voz?
